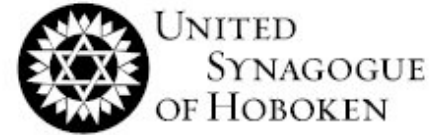

Pregnancy

Shalom Baby- A workshop for expectant parents. Enhance your preparation for welcoming a new child into your family and the Jewish community. Learn about values, customs and community resources available to help as the family grows. Please watch the Shofar or contact the office to find out about enrollment.

3 months- 10 months

Baby Sing - For infants to babies 10 months old (and a caregiver), this class will feature songs and stories geared just right for little ones developing language. Adults get a chance to meet and chat as well as spend time singing and dancing with their baby. Class meets Wednesdays from 1:30-2:15. Check the USH website or call the preschool office to find out about enrollment.

Jewish Parenting Connection – Lunch and Learn with Rabbi Scheinberg. We'll discuss topics of interest to families of young children and various approaches to Jewish parenting. Open to the community, free of charge. Check the USH website for more information.

December 14, 2011 12:30-1:30 and May 2, 2012 12:30-1:30.

6 months- 2 years

Shabbat Shira - Once a month on the second Saturday for infants through age 2 ½ years and a parent, this class sings and plays in a "Toddler Shabbat." This program is free and meets from 11:00-12:00.

Toddlers- This program for children (ages 6 months to 2 years old and their parents/ caregivers) includes songs, play, movement, and Jewish holiday celebration. This program includes a Shabbat sing-along with challah!

2-3 years

Two's Program- A great introduction to school:: the children have fun in our happy, nurturing and exciting classroom while learning basic preschool concepts. With the support of a caregiver our two year olds can begin to get used to a more structured school environment. The program includes the celebration of Jewish holidays plus art, stories, snack, music, play dough, outside time in our yard and more. Check the USH website or call the preschool office to find out about enrollment and fees.

B'Yachad Shabbat Class (Saturdays for 2 & 3 year olds with a parent.) - This program includes Shabbat prayers and songs, dancing and storytelling. This program occurs every first and third Shabbat morning from 11:00 – 12:00 and is free.

Havdalah: Join us at USH as we say goodbye to Shabbat and hello to the week together, in this lovely, brief, evening, child- friendly ceremony.

Shabbat in the Park: Welcome Shabbat with your family and friends at Church Square Park at 6pm. Once a month from May – September. Bring a picnic dinner; we'll bring the challah, grape juice and Shabbat songs.

Shabbat Babysitting: Saturdays 10:30am – 12:30pm for Toddlers through age 5 years old . We are happy to provide babysitting during Shabbat morning services, to enable parents to attend services. This program occurs every Shabbat and is free but requires preregistration.

The PJ Library- The PJ Library mails high-quality Jewish children's books to families on a monthly basis, at no cost to the family. The United Synagogue of Hoboken is the cooperating organization for this program for children 6 months to 5 years old who reside in Hoboken, Jersey City and Bayonne.
