

KOSHER CATERERS

All foods brought into the United Synagogue of Hoboken buildings must be kosher. The best guarantee of the kosher status of a food product is the presence of a heksher - a symbol of Rabbinic supervision - on the food package. A partial list of hekshers can be found at: <http://www.jewishcooking.org/kosher-symbols.html> (2 pages). Note: The letter "K" by itself sometimes signifies reliable Kashrut supervision and sometimes does not. Please consult the rabbi in such cases.

Certain foods are presumed to be kosher, and no rabbinical supervision is necessary. Such foods include:

- fresh fruits and vegetables
- most canned or frozen fruits and juices (unless they contain grape juice)
- frozen vegetables (without sauces or additional ingredients)
- milk
- eggs

As a rule, food cooked in a private kitchen may not be brought into the synagogue. Exceptions are made for members of the congregation who maintain a strict level of kashrut in their home kitchens; please check with Rabbi Scheinberg if you wish to bring food from your home.

The following are some products with Kashrut supervision:

- Entenmann's
- Pepperidge Farm Cookies

A strict separation must be maintained between dairy foods and meat foods. Following a meat meal in the synagogue, dairy foods may not be served for at least three hours.

At a Bar/Bat Mitzvah or an Aufruf (special honor for a couple about to be married), the family may elect to shower the child or couple with candy. The ONLY candies permitted for this purpose (for reasons of Kashrut as well as safety) are individually wrapped Sunkist Fruit Gems. Candies are to be provided by the host.

There is some debate in the Conservative Movement concerning the kashrut of cheese and wine. In the synagogue, however, we follow the stricter opinion on both of these issues. Cheese and wine must have a heksher to be brought into the synagogue.
